Spring Greetings:

After one year in operation, our website is improving and we are seeing positive response. If you have not had a chance to check it out, please do. The website is **omahavalleycemetery.com**. There is information about the cemetery, a place to make donations, and a place to include your email address.

Last fall we finally developed a plan for the structure to house our directory and we received a donation specifically for the construction. Unfortunately, we were delayed by the weather. Plans are back on track so look for progress very soon. Our Avenue of Flags will be raised again this Memorial Day weekend.

Because Omaha Valley Cemetery is a private, non-profit organization, we depend totally and solely on your donations, lot sales, and perpetual care investment interest for our support. Our volunteer board serves and makes decisions regarding the cemetery. As family members of someone buried at the cemetery, we rely on you for our financial needs and thankfully you have been generous – the cemetery is one of the most beautiful in the area.

In 2024 we received a little over \$14,000 in donations and sold 10 lots. We had 8 burials. We paid \$9750 for mowing, \$1052 for snow removal and had \$2214 in maintenance expense, and \$208 in office expense. Because of your financial support, we continue to meet the needs of the cemetery. Thank you!!

**Things to remember:**

- Lots are currently selling for \$750 each.
- Consider purchasing a grave marker or stone for your loved ones buried at the cemetery. There are still many unmarked graves which makes it very difficult for the locator when someone passes.
- Help us with names and addresses of related family members so that they too can receive our mailing.
- Keep your cemetery deeds in a safe place, these prove your ownership and lot number for burial.
- Grave stones and their maintenance are the responsibility of the lot owner.
- Use unbreakable containers when decorating and remove them by **June 10th** so mowing can continue unobstructed. Cemetery cleanup after this date will remove **all remaining decorations and items** not on the stone foundation.
